

Installing Windows 98 in VPC7

To install Windows 98 you must have a Windows 98 CD-ROM and Product key.

1. Verify that there is not an existing VM named Windows 98 in the VPC list, if there is, rename it.
2. Shutdown VPC completely.
3. Copy the Windows 98 package into the Virtual PC List folder under your Documents Folder.
4. Start Virtual PC. Windows 98 will appear in the list.
5. Start Windows 98.
6. After it loads, follow the on-screen directions.

Note: The Windows 98 CD-ROM can be mounted to the running Windows VM by either dragging and dropping the CD-ROM icon from the desktop to the CD-ROM icon in the VPC tray, or by clicking the CD-ROM icon in the VPC tray and then clicking “capture disk”

Complete the Windows installation by following the on-screen prompts. Additional information on installing Windows can be found here:
